Most of the day-to-day ledger updates are the responsibility of the Bookkeeper, who reports to the Treasurer. Experience with, or the desire to learn, MS-Excel and Sage Accounting software would be beneficial. Time required would average 4 hours per week, with additional time required for yearly budget preparation/consultation and year-end reporting (late January).
