CHRISTMAS IS JUST AROUND THE CORNER. Many are already looking at what to buy for those special people in our lives. We thank you for remembering to purchase your shopping card in advance and helping the church in its fundraising effort.

TREASURER NEEDED - The primary role of the Treasurer is to manage and maintain the church's financial records and procedures and to provide periodic status reports to various entities within the church: Advisory Board, Finance Committee, Wardens and Vestry. Most of the day-to-day ledger updates are the responsibility of the Bookkeeper, who reports to the Treasurer. Experience with, or the desire to learn, MS-Excel and Sage Accounting software would be beneficial. Time required would average 4 hours per week, with additional time required for yearly budget preparation/consultation and year-end reporting (late January).
