The Season of Creation

The Season of Creation, beginning on September 1st and running until October 4th, is a time for churches to reflect on and renew their relationship with God and all creation through prayer and action for the church. This year's theme is "Listen to the Voice of Creation," this year's symbol is the burning bush, and the highlighted scripture is Exodus 3:1-12. Below is an excerpt from the seasonofcreation.org website explaining the concept for this year's theme.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, many have become familiar with the concept of being muted in conversations. Many voices are muted in public discourse around climate change and the ethics of Earth-keeping. These are voices of those who suffer the impacts of climate change. These are voices of people who hold generational wisdom about how to live gratefully within the limits of the land. These are voices of a diminishing diversity of more-than-human species. **It is the voice of the Earth.** *"I have heard their cry...I know their sufferings...Come, now! I will send you...I will be with you"* Exodus 3: 1-12 The burning bush is the Symbol for the Season of Creation 2022. Today, the prevalence of unnatural fires are a sign of the devastating effects that climate change has on the most vulnerable of our planet. Creation cries out as forests crackle, animals flee, and people are forced to migrate due to the fires of injustice. On the contrary, the fire that called to Moses as he tended the flock on Mt. Horeb did not consume or destroy the bush. This flame of the Spirit revealed God's presence. This holy fire affirmed that God heard the cries of all who suffered, and

promised to be with us as we followed in faith to our deliverance from injustice. In this Season of Creation, this symbol of God's Spirit calls us to listen to the voice of creation.
