Holy Week services : For Holy Week St. Paul's is pleased to offer a number of different services to enrich our journey towards cross, culminating in the joy of the Resurrection on Easter morning. Below is some detail about a couple of our services. Rev Bonnie is always happy to answer your questions about any service.

Tenebrae – Wednesday, April 5 at 7:00 pm This is an ancient service which prepares us for the dark and difficult time that our Lord experiences during the Passion. The central focus of this service is the diminishing light as gradually all of the candles are extinguished leaving a single candle. This light is then hidden for a brief period of time to signify Jesus' death before reappearing. At the very end, a loud noise is made, symbolizing the earthquake at the time of the resurrection (Mt. 28:2). Bringing a flashlight is suggested.

Agape – Thursday, April 6 at 12 noon: All are invited to join together to share in an Agape meal. Held on Maundy Thursday, this is a time of food, fellowship, praise and worship, held around a table as a reminder of Jesus eating and drinking with the Apostles at the Last Supper. Agape is a Greek word signifying the love that God has for us and that we have for Him. You are asked to please sign up for this meal so that those preparing are aware of numbers. Our meal this year is soup and a biscuit provided by Sisterhood, there is no cost for the meal but a free will offering, will be accepted.
