Outreach

Our Outreach Committee has determined that it would be helpful to to some in our neighborhood to have a small source to top up necessary food supplies., when in need. Diane Stecher is building the cupboard to be put in place near the sidewalk in our quadrangle. The cost of the cupboard is very low as we have been able to secure many used , donated articles for the construction.

We will try to keep it stocked with non –perishable and personal hygiene items on a regular basis. We hope to receive some contribution of these items from our congregation, and hopefully, from those able in our surrounding community. We pray that God will guide us in providing this assistance in our area.

Our cupboard will be similar to this but with a peaked style roof, going the opposite way with an overhang at the front, and we will use plex glass in the doors. Below is an example of what a cupboard could look like.



This is a list of items we still need for construction of the Cupboard

4. sturdy metal stakes and hardware to use with 4×4 wood (Rona @ \$ 20.00 each),

Barrel bolt for the doors,

- 2. handles for the doors,
- 4. Hinges for the doors.
