The **Season of Spiritual Renewal** is now well underway. Below is an excerpt of an email from Judy Paulsen, Coordinator.

Between now and Epiphany 2026, the diocese will be offering **resources and workshops** that we hope will strengthen and encourage all our churches. Some workshops are geared to priests and deacons, some to lay leaders of various ministries, while several are intended for everyone wanting to grow and be renewed in their faith.

The workshops being offered from September to December have now been scheduled and are listed on the diocesan website (**click on the 'Season of Spiritual Renewal' tab on the diocesan website's homepage.**) As you'll see, most workshops are being offered in a **1 to 2 pm time-slot**. This will enable lay people to participate during their lunch hour and will also enable many clergy to participate since many attend parish meetings in the evenings.

Registration for the fall workshops will open on August 27th.
