PWRDF - Responding to the Horn of Africa Drought

The PWRDF is responding to the drought emergency in the Horn of Africa through the ACT (Alliance and Canadian Foodgrains Bank.) An initial \$75,000 has been sent by PWRDF to support relief in Ethiopia, Somalia and Kenya. **The government of Canada will match donations dollar for dollar until Sept. 16.**

You may make donations to the Primate's fund through your envelope givings. St. Paul's then forwards all donations to the PWRDF in its effort to assist people affected by the drought.
