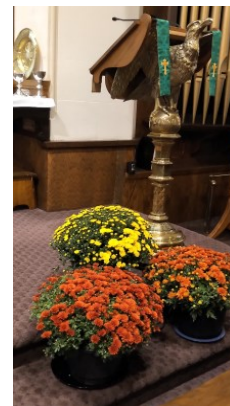

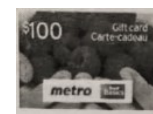
As the song says: I Am The Church, You Are The Church, We Are The Church Together.....
