Quilt Draw Winner: Kay S.

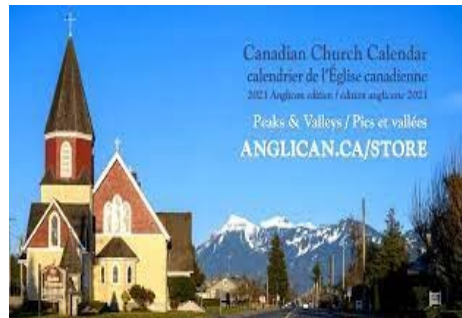

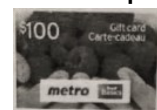
Our 1st **MESSY CHURCH** event went well!
