








Remembrance Day Services at St. Paul's:

On November 20th, St Paul's will hand out white ribbons as we join millions of others around the world in the "White Ribbon Campaign". This is a movement started by a few men in London, ON in 1991 in response to the Montreal Massacre, with the aim of men taking a bigger role in ending violence against women. You may remember that in December 1989 a gunman killed 14 bright young women (12 of whom were engineering students) at the Ecole Polytechique in Montreal because of his misogynistic views and dislike of women in male-dominated careers. Now, over 30 years later, the White Ribbon Campaign has spread from Ontario to 60 countries including the U.K. and Australia.

The international White Ribbon Day is November 25th and people wear them until about December 6th, when prayers vigils are often held to remember victims of gender-based violence. When you wear your white ribbon you are showing others that you pledge to not commit, condone or keep silent about gender-based violence. As Christians, this is not a pledge just for men but for all of us. Each of us has a role to take in making "thy kingdom come" a reality. Please join with Rev Bonnie and wear your white ribbon beginning on Nov 20th. More information will follow.
