Please join us this Sunday as we “welcome back” everyone after the summer. Then, stay for our special “Make Your Own Sundae” treat! Yum!

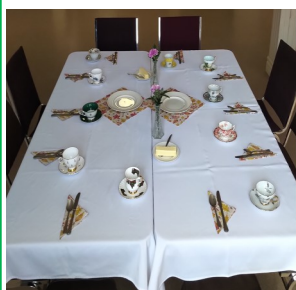


Do you like to sing?
